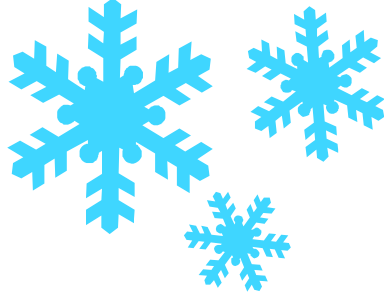

ANNUAL CONGREGATIONAL MEETING RECAP

Thanks to everyone who took part in the Annual Congregational meeting on Tuesday, February 2. If you were not able to be there, here is a recap of that meeting.

1) We accepted the proposed budget of \$337,000 to support the ministries of West End Baptist and our partners for 2010.

2) We accepted the proposal to hire a part time Director for the ministries of Newfoundland Adventure Camp.

3) We accepted the proposal to hire a part time Director of Worship.

4) We accepted the report from the Nominating Committee of those willing to serve on the various boards and committees of the church. **All of the Boards and committee positions have been filled except for one spot on the Board of Missions.**

5) Brochures were distributed reminding us that we now have the option of being able to give our tithes and offerings through an automatic withdrawal program that is safe and easy. **(These brochures are available on the table in the foyer.)**

6) We accepted the proposal that Pastor Gordon be given the church's endorsement to begin studies towards a Doctorate of Ministry degree beginning this summer.

7) As a church that believes our mission statement: *(Growing Disciples who take Christ's love to lost and hurting people)*, calls us to be actively involved in the wider community, we acknowledged and affirmed the work and witness of Neil and Margaret MacNaughton through their involvement with Ezra Chaplaincy especially during the days following the crash of the Cougar Helicopter last March.
